3. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

I. Ordinary Diploma & Technician Certificate in Pharmaceutical sciences (PST)

Ordinary level (CSEE) four passes, D and above of non-religious subjects including Chemistry and Biology. English, Physics and Mathematics are added advantages.

II. Ordinary Diploma & Technician Certificate in Social Work (SW)

Ordinary level (CSEE) any four passes, D and above of non-religious subjects, Basic technician certificate NTA level 4 in Community Health or Social work.

Holders of Basic Technician Certificate (NTA Level 4) in Social Work, Gender, Community Development, Youth Work or Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with At Least one Principal Pass and one Subsidiary in Principal Subjects.

III. Ordinary Diploma and Technician Certificate in Clinical Medicine (CMT)

Ordinary level (CSEE) four passes, D and above of non-religious subjects including Biology, Chemistry, and Physics/Engineering science, English and Mathematics are added advantages

IV. Ordinary Diploma in Veterinary Laboratory Technology (VLT)

Ordinary level (CSEE) four passes, D and above of non-religious subjects including two passes in Biology, Chemistry, Physics/Engineering Sciences, Basic Mathematics, Agriculture Science and Geography OR National Vocation Award (NVA) III/Trade Test I in Animal Health with Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE).

V. Ordinary Diploma and Technician Certificate in Nursing and Midwifery (NMT)

Ordinary level (CSEE) four passes, D and above of non-religious subjects including Biology, Chemistry, and Physics/Engineering science

VI. Ordinary Diploma in Health Records and Information Technology (HRIT)

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with at least four (4) passes including Chemistry, Biology, Basic Mathematics and English Language.

VII. Ordinary Diploma and Technician Certificate in Medical Laboratory Sciences (MLT)

Ordinary level (CSEE) four passes, D and above of non-religious subjects including Biology, Chemistry, and Physics/Engineering science, English and Mathematics are added advantages

VIII. Ordinary Diploma in Community Development (CD)

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with at least four (4) passes in non-religious subject.

Holders of Basic Technician Certificate (NTA Level 4) in Community Development, Social Work, Gender, Youth Work OR Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least one Principal pass and one Subsidiary in Principal subjects

IX. National Vocational Award LEVEL I, II and III of Laboratory Assistant

Ordinary level (CSEE) One pass, D and above

4. REQUIREMENTS FOR BOARDING/HOSTEL STUDENTS

1 blanket, 4 bed sheets, 1 pillow + 2 pillow cases, 1 mosquito net, 1 plastic buckets, Towels, Open shoes/sandals and canvas shoes for casual stay

All other outfits after classes MUST be of good manner.

5. REQUIREMENTS FOR PAYMENTS OF SCHOOL FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

- (i) School fees and meal : Fees should be paid **in full** at the beginning of each academic year or **in Four installments for (Clinical Medicine, Nursing, Medical Laboratory Sciences, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Social Work, Veterinary Laboratory Technology, Health Records and Information Technology, Community Development)** and **Two installments for Laboratory Assistant** at the beginning of each semester
- (ii) Hostel charges should be paid **in two installments** at the beginning of each academic year.
- (iii) Fees once paid will not be refunded if a student withdraws or leaves the College without permission from the Principal or is disqualified in examination or dismissed for indiscipline.
- (iv) However, **fifty percent (50%)** of fees may be refunded, if a student notifies the Principal to withdraw from the college within first four weeks from the beginning of the academic year.
- (v) Payment by Cheque, International Money Orders (IMO) etc is accepted prior to clearance by the bank.

NOTE: Payment by M-Pesa, Tigo Pesa, and Airtel Money or any mobile number is **STRICTLY NOT ACCEPTED. WE DO NOT HAVE ANY AGENTS FOR FEES OR ANY OTHER CHARGE COLLECTION.**

- (vi) All payment should be done through College Bank Accounts and not otherwise.
